Description	<p>Type: Gallery Range</p> <p>Danger area: Limited Danger Area (LDA)</p> <p>Location (What 3 words): DIVIDE.HILLS.STOVE (600yds)</p> <p>Distance: 100 – 600yds</p> <p>Targets:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 128 target lanes divided into 10 butts • Butt 10: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 20 lanes for primary use of the 300m shed ○ Lanes 1 – 10 are Kongsberg electronic targets ○ 3 x McQueen Castles can be fitted • Butts 11 – 19: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 12 target lanes per butt ○ McQueen Castles can be fitted on lanes 70, 72, 85, 87, 89, and 97 ○ Butt 14 contains 12 Intarso electronic targets ○ Lanes 103 – 108 are Kongsberg electronic targets <p>Additional notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Excluding specific NRA events 100yds can only be shot on Butts 18 & 19

RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS	
Coordinating Instructions	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shooting on this range affects the following ranges: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Stickledown (Butts) b. BSG (Cottesloe Heath) c. Bisley Pay & Play (Long Siberia) 2. Access: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. To the butts is via the Markers walkway or Hobsons Way b. All firers must access and egress from the 600yd firing point of the appropriate Butt unless prior permission granted by Range Control

	<p>3. Vehicles are not permitted on the range floor without prior permission from the range office</p> <p>a. Golf buggies are permitted. In extreme weather conditions, Range Safety may restrict their use in certain areas where necessary.</p> <p>4. Priority:</p> <p>a. If the NRA DOES NOT have priority, shooting is not permitted on Butts 10-13 inclusive (to target 36)</p> <p>b. If the NRA HAS priority but the NCSC are operating, all areas forward of the 300yd point in Butts 10-13 are out of bounds</p> <p>c. If the NRA HAS priority, access to Cottesloe Heath (excluding Clock Tower layouts) is not permitted</p> <p>5. If 300m shed is in use the following restrictions apply:</p> <p>a. 300yd shooting is permitted from target 1</p> <p>b. 400yds shooting is not permitted below (left of) Target 8</p> <p>c. 500yds shooting is not permitted below (left of) Target 13</p> <p>d. 600yds shooting is not permitted below (left of) Target 21</p> <p>6. MOD restrictions:</p> <p>a. Permitted to use Butts 11-17</p> <p>b. When butt 17 is in use, Long Siberia restrictions are to be applied</p> <p>c. Cadet units must apply the 200mil rule in accordance with DOSR Regulatory Notice 23-1</p> <p>7. 600yds shooting is not permitted on lane 108</p> <p>8. McQueen castles are only permitted to be engaged from 200 and 300yds</p> <p>9. No fire with movement is permitted in Butt 19 except for specified NRA events</p> <p>10. Courses of fire that involve movement (other than changing firing position e.g. from standing to kneeling) with a loaded firearm are forbidden except with prior authority of the CE</p> <p>11. Gates:</p> <p>a. The 300m Shed gate must be closed and locked if shooting is from a distance greater than 300m in Butts 10, 11 or 12</p> <p>b. The 500yd gate must be closed and locked if there is shooting from 600yds in Butts 11, 12 or 13</p> <p>c. The 300yd gate on the right hand side must be closed if shooting is from a distance greater than 300x in Butt 19</p>
<p>Firing Positions</p>	<p>12. All firing is to be conducted from the left of pegs</p> <p>13. Positions permitted:</p> <p>a. Prone</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> b. Supine c. Sitting d. Kneeling/squatting e. Standing f. Benched g. Lanes 73-108 at 400yds inclusive, prone/supine shooting is not permitted <p>14. Sporting stances on electronic targets are only permitted up to 100x</p> <p>15. Permission to fire from any position other than prone/supine, or use a muzzle brake, must be notified in the booking request and granted by the Range Office in order to allow suitable target allocation on the range</p>
Targetry	<p>16. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and /or appropriate shooting station or peg. Any deviation from this is to be notified, in writing, and approved by the Range Services Manager</p> <p>17. Self-provided targets may be used with permission from the Range Office and must be placed within the 0.9m x 0.9m correx pin - on</p> <p>18. Handheld targets are only to be exposed in or in front of target frames</p> <p>19. Handheld targets not supplied by the NRA require to be notified at the time of the booking due to possible frame removal</p> <p>20. Laterally moving targets are not permitted on Gallery ranges</p>
