FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION	
Permitted firearms and ammunition including ME & MV	<p>Type: Rifles; gallery rifles and pistols by special arrangement only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum Muzzle Velocity: 1000 m/s (3280 ft/s) • Maximum Muzzle Energy: 4500 J (3319 ft/lb) • HME Permitted: 4500J – 7000J HME procedures apply <p>Type: Vermin calibres</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum Muzzle Velocity: 1350 m/s (4429 ft/s) • Maximum Muzzle Energy: 2600 J (1918 ft/lb) • Fragmenting or varmint ammunition must not be used on hard targets <p>Shooting forward of the 100yd firing point</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum Muzzle Velocity: 655 m/s (2150 ft/s) • Maximum Muzzle Energy: 2030 J (1496 ft/lb) <p>Special requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Muzzle brakes permitted with consent of adjacent shooters • Shotguns by prior arrangement only <p>Not permitted</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • .22-250 • .220 Swift • Muzzle loading/Black Powder firearms are not to be discharged on any electronic scoring targets

	<p>d. Pirbright</p> <p>2. Access:</p> <p>a. All movement forward of the Statics Range firing point requires the following ranges to have ceased fire, and must be coordinated by the BSR manager or delegate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Statics ii. Running Boar iii. Running Deer iv. 50 Yard Zeroing <p>b. When there are personnel forward of the firing points, the red flag system is to be followed under the direction of the BSR Manager or delegate</p> <p>c. When shooting is conducted from the turning target firing points on Running Deer, the BSR Manager is to ensure demarcation lines are set up between Running Deer and Statics range to ensure safe access/egress</p> <p>d. When shooting is conducted forward of the statics 100 yd firing point, the BSR manager is to ensure there is no shooting on the Running Boar, Running Deer or 50m Zeroing Ranges</p> <p>3. Range infrastructure is not to be used as targetry or to zero/check zero firearms</p> <p>4. A Suitably Qualified Experience Person (SQEP) is to be appointed as the responsible RO when shooting</p> <p>5. Vehicles are not permitted on the range floor without prior permission from the BSR manager</p>
<p>Firing positions</p>	<p>6. Positions permitted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Prone b. Sitting c. Kneeling d. Standing e. Benched f. Shooting distance forward of the 100yd firing point with prior approval from BSR Manager <p>7. When shooters are firing from different positions there is to be a common firing line.</p> <p>8. Changes of position are permitted within any detail or practice outside competition providing all firers follow the same sequence, and in competition in accordance with the conditions</p>
<p>Targetry</p>	<p>9. MAX TCH: 1.5m</p> <p>10. Only targets from the BSR approved set may be used</p> <p>11. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and/or appropriate shooting station or peg. Any deviation from this is to be notified and approved by the BSR Manager</p>

	12. Falling Plates or other hard targets may not be engaged within Statics Range
