<b>Description</b>	<p><b>Type:</b> Non Standard</p> <p><b>Danger area:</b> No Danger Area (NDA)</p> <p><b>Location</b> (What 3 words): Topped.Fetch.Wonderfully</p> <p><b>Distance:</b> 5m – 25m</p> <p><b>Targets:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 20 turning targets (4x banks of 5)</li> </ul> <p><b>Additional notes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Night shooting permitted</li> </ul>

<b>RANGE SAFETY LIMITATIONS</b>	
<b>Coordinating Instructions</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Shooting on this range has no effect on any other ranges</li> <li>2. <b>Access:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. If Bay A is in use: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. Access is via the RHS gate on the range</li> <li>ii. The shutter between Bay A &amp; B is to be lowered</li> <li>iii. Heritage pistol is not permitted</li> </ol> </li> <li>b. If Bay A is not in use access can be via the club room</li> <li>c.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Range infrastructure is not to be used as targetry or to zero/check firearms</li> <li>4. A Suitably Qualified Experienced Person (SQEP) is to be appointed as the responsible RO when shooting on Bay B.</li> <li>5. Alcohol is not permitted in the Club Room</li> </ol>

<p><b>Firing Positions</b></p>	<p>6. <b>Positions Permitted:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Kneeling</li> <li>b. Standing</li> <li>c. Benched</li> </ul> <p>7. Small-bore target rifles may be used for prone or 3-position shooting to NSRA or ISSF rules with prior permission from the Range Office.</p> <p>8. Permission to fire from any other position, or use a muzzle brake, must be notified in the booking request and granted by the Range Office.</p> <p>9. Changes of position are permitted within any detail or practice outside competition providing all firers follow the same sequence, and in competition in accordance with the conditions</p> <p>10. Fire with movement (i.e. changing location during a detail with a loaded firearm) is permitted within NRA competitions or following NRA approval of the proposed Coff, and then only if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. The movement area is clearly delineated by objects or markers that do not constitute a trip hazard</li> <li>b. Only one firer is on the range at a time</li> <li>c. All movement is controlled by an RO who is responsible for the practice</li> </ul>
<p><b>Targetry</b></p>	<p>11. <b>MAX TCH: 1.5m</b></p> <p>12. Targets are to be used in the frames or holders provided and are to be engaged only from the recognised firing points and /or appropriate shooting station or peg. Any deviation from this is to be notified, in writing, and approved by the Range Services Manager</p> <p>13. Skittles, falling plates or other hard targets may not be engaged within Cheylesmore Range</p> <p>14. Clay pigeons are not to be engaged within Cheylesmore Range</p>
